IMPORTANT! German citizenship is not necessary.



Who can vote?

- All senior citizens who have reached the age of 60 by the deadline for the Senior Citizens' Council elections,
- and have their main residence in Berlin

How and when can I vote?

- Go to the polling station announced by your district! (14 – 18 March 2022)
- Apply for your postal ballot (by 28 February 2022).
- Vote by postal ballot! (by 12 March 2022, 6 pm)

What is a District Senior Citizens' Council?

- A District Senior Citizens' Council is an interest group for senior citizens. It advocates for the social participation, inclusion and involvement of older people in the district.

What are the tasks of the District Senior Citizens' Council?

- Advice and support for older people in asserting their claims
- Representing the interests of Berlin's senior citizens in public
- Development of proposals for planned measures in the district
